

Recycling Continues to Grow





We ensure compliance with objectives

To ensure that all European countries use the same measurement criteria to harmonise recycling rates, Decision 2019/665 of 17 April 2019, based on Directive 2018/852, established a new calculation methodology. This methodology will be used by the EU to monitor recycling targets and is mandatory for all Member States.

Under this new methodology, the amount of tonnes recycled, which was previously measured when materials reached recycling facilities, is now measured at a more advanced stage of the recycling process. This change accounts for losses inherent to the industrial process, providing a more accurate measure of actual recycling.

By adhering to this new criterion, we have exceeded both the 2023 targets and the goals set by Europe for 2025, achieving them two years ahead of schedule.

Efficient investment in circularity

With your contribution and involvement, you make it possible to fund the recycling of lightweight household packaging, as required by regulations. This system ensures that the costs of management are allocated to each material. At Ecoembes, we strive for maximum efficiency in these costs, which is reflected in the agreements we have had with the administration for nearly three decades.

Ecoembes is a non-profit organisation, meaning we balance costs and revenues. If they are not equal in a given year, any surplus or deficit is adjusted in the following year. The losses for 2023 are due to the return of the previous year's surplus to companies, something we achieve by reducing the fee paid by companies in 2023.
